Including eight private collections, the public has access to diverse dimensions, such as archaeology, ethnography, mineralogy, paleontology, ceramic tiles and tins, covering millions of years. Being part of the great universe of Berardo Collection, these collections are the result of the constant effort of José Berardo in collecting and caring for objects of scientific, artistic, historical or sentimental importance.

Óbidos

AN HISTORIC VISIT TO THE WORLD OF WINE AND ARCHITECTURE

In Vila Fresca de Azeitão among cypresses is the entrance gate of Quinta da Bacalhôa, considered one of the finest vineyards of Portugal. It was the house of D. Brites, mother of Manuel I, in the fifteenth century and bought by Brás de Albuquerque, the eldest son of Afonso de Albuquerque. This new owner embellished the palace with panels of coloured tiles, changing the turrets of the house and building a new house near the lake. Take a walk through the gardens of this house and taste the wines of Bacalhôa Wines of Portugal after a visit at the winery.

Arrábida


The Arrábida is distinguished by the predominance of green that stretches almost to the sea. The Mediterranean vegetation is of immense wealth, so Arrábida was transformed into a National Park to protect it. Explore the Park and get involved by its natural beauty.

The Grape Harvest Has Begun

The Group Bacalhôa grape harvest has begun yesterday (August 22nd) and the first white grape, Fernão Pires and Viognier, were harvested in the vineyards of Alentejo. Hugo Carvalho, winemaker responsible for the wines of this region, underlined his enthusiasm with the quality of the grapes.

On August 22nd, the first grapes harvested for Bacalhôa Group's wines entered the winery at Quinta do Carmo.. Hugo Carvalho believes that this harvest will be very good and is very pleased with the quality of the grapes. The next harvest of white varieties, Antão Vaz, Arinto and Roupeiro, grapes used at Quinta do Carmo White, will begin next Monday.

On August 17th, 2011 grapes were being cut at the legendary Quinta do Carmo, registering a slight delay compared to last year. The quality in this year's harvest, though there is a delay in picking the grapes, has surpassed expectations. The high temperatures in July caused a lower yield of the vineyard. The berries are smaller which potentially confers a greater focus on wines produced. In August, the nights have been cooler, helping the grapes to increase the acidity levels gradually and



slowly ripen, ensuring higher quality. Vasco Penha Garcia, coordinator of enology, believes that the first white wines are promising.

Next week, the winery at Vila Nogueira de Azeitão in the Setúbal Peninsula and the main winery at Aliança Vinhos de Portugal in Bairrada, will be receiving the first white grapes. At Quinta dos Loridos, grape collection will also begin after the weekend for the base wines for the sparkling wines.

At the beginning of September it is expected that the harvest will begin for the grape variety Encruzado in the Dão region. In the Douro, the red grapes for the Quinta dos Quatro Ventos wines will be received at the winery also at the beginning of the month. The vineyard in the region of Beiras will be the last to be harvested, scheduled for the end of September.

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JP Azeitão White and Red in Bag-in-Box - Summer packaging

This summer Bacalhôa Wines of Portugal suggests the packaging Bag-in-box (BiB) and launches the JP White Azeitão 2011. Together with JP Azeitão Tinto 2011, also in BiB, the Bacalhôa Wines of Portugal highlights the benefits of using this type of packaging in leisure time right at this time of year.



The JP Azeitão White 2011 enters the market shaped in 3 liters Bag-in-Box (BiB). Will join JP Azeitão Red 2011, also in BiB, forming the perfect duo for socializing and leisure activities so common at this season. To take to the beach or the countryside, for picnic or barbecue, the advantages of this type of packaging are unlimited.

The Bag-in-Box is a very practical proposal for summer tours. The wine is stored in a flexible resistant bag and suitable for the preservation of wine. Wine is vacuum packed inside the bag and closes on itself as air is withdrawn from it, this prevents the entry of air and subsequent oxidation of the wine.

Another advantage relates to the weight, since a 3 litre container is about 38% lighter than four bottles of 0.75 l. They are undoubtedly good reasons for this summer, to choose for JP Azeitão White and Red in BiB.

The good news does not end there. This type of packaging does not break; it is resistant, 100% recyclable and allows dosing the wine to be served through the tap associated with the flexible bag. Once opened this kind of packaging, guarantee the quality of the wine for a longer time, between 1 up to 2 months, being a factor undoubtedly superior to what happens with traditional glass bottles. For all these reasons, this summer, we recommend beach and countryside, barbecue and picnic with JP

White and Red 2011 in Bag-in-Box.
